- Access to healthcare such as COVID-19 risk assessments, depression, anxiety, flu, cold, rashes, allergies, infections, and more!
- Prescriptions (when appropriate), or referrals when needed.

*****TWIC Enrollment Requirements***** Effective July 1, 2015 the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) adopted new enrollment requirements for U.S. born TWIC applicants. TSA is making this change to align TWIC proof-of-citizenship requirements with those of other TSA Programs. Before applying for a TWIC card, be sure to visit WWW.TSA.GOV/FOR-INDUSTRY/TWIC to review the updated list of acceptable documentation.
