International Brotherhood of Boilermakers Scholarship - To be eligible the applicant must be a son, daughter. legally adopted child or dependent of a member in good standing. Applications are limited to high school seniors who will be entering their first year of academic study at a degree-granting accredited college or university within one year of their high school graduation. Scholarship candidates should visit the secure Boilermaker Scholarship website at scholarships.boilermakers.org to submit their application and supporting documents. Applications may be submitted between January 1st and March 1st. Applications will not be accepted after the March 1st deadline.

**Pennsylvania AFL-CIO Scholarship** - Scholarships are available from the Pennsylvania AFL-CIO for graduating high school seniors and post-secondary students. The scholarships are only awarded to Pennsylvania AFL-CIO affiliated union members and their families. **Please contact Tina at the union hall if you would like to have an application mailed to you. All submissions must be postmarked by March 28, 2023**. Essays will be judged in April, and awards will be made in May 2023.

**Scholarship Memorial Cards** are available from the office. These cards can be obtained by sending a check payable to the Local 13 Scholarship Program for \$10.00 either with the name and address where the card is to be sent or have the card forwarded to your home to have available for services. A memorial page will appear in the 2023 Scholarship Program in honor of those we would like to remember.

**Monthly Dues increased to \$57.70 per month effective February 1, 2023.** Remember to put your registration number on your check. Local 13 will no longer be able to cover members who allow their dues to go into arrears!!! A \$500.00 reinstatement fee will be imposed. It is your obligation to the union to pay your dues on time.

Pay Monthly Dues Online - Members have the option of paying membership dues online. Visit the local's website at <a href="www.boilermakers13.org">www.boilermakers13.org</a>, select "Member Resources" then "Online Dues". A convenience fee is added to each transaction. Please note, username is your last name, and your password is your registration number. If you have any issues with the portal, please notify the hall immediately. Local 13 will no longer be able to cover members who allow their dues to go into arrears!!! A \$500.00 reinstatement fee will be imposed. It is your obligation to the union to pay your dues on time. Monthly dues receipts are being emailed to members with a valid email address on file. If you do not have an email address on file, a paper receipt will be mailed as normal. Please monitor your email inbox to make sure you are receiving dues receipts and contact the hall immediately if you believe there is a problem.

**Short and Long List** - Effective January 1, 2022, any member who works fifteen (15) days or less will maintain their long position on the list.

Dispatch Time - Please be advised that you can be called for work anytime, not just after 2:00 pm so stay by your phones! Also, remember to call in your layoff on the day you are laid off. Although it is the duty of the job steward to call in layoffs, it is ultimately the member's responsibility to contact the union hall. The best way to inform the union hall of your layoff is to call the union hall after 4:00 p.m. and leave a message on the recorder that you were laid off. Leave the date you were laid off and the name of the job you were laid off from.

**TWIC Enrollment Requirements -** Effective July 1, 2015, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) adopted new enrollment requirements for U.S. born TWIC applicants. TSA is making this change to align TWIC proof-of-citizenship requirements with those of other TSA Programs. Before applying for a TWIC card, be sure to visit WWW.TSA.GOV/FOR-INDUSTRY/TWIC to review the updated list of acceptable documentation.

Please check the expiration date of your TWIC Card to make sure it has not expired. The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) enhanced the renewal process for the Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC®) to help support critical transportation workers. Starting August 11, 2022, TSA enabled the ability for current TWIC holders to renew their credentials online, which eliminates the need to go to an enrollment center and makes the five-year renewal process more convenient. Nearly 60 percent of TWIC holders renew their card every five years. Renewing online [universalenroll.dhs.gov] eliminates the need to go to an enrollment center, supports U.S. critical infrastructure and supply chain workers, and saves travel time and expenses associated with being away from work. Most eligible applicants receive their TWIC card in less than 10 days. Those applicants with more complex cases may require 60 days or longer for processing. Applicants may check their TWIC status online [universalenroll.dhs.gov] at any time. Most applicants, including U.S. citizens, nationals, and lawful permanent residents, will be able to renew online without the need to visit an enrollment center. Please visit TSA's enrollment provider website [universalenroll.dhs.gov] for information on TWIC enrollments and renewals. If applicants encounter difficulty renewing online, they may contact customer service at (855) 347-8371. For more information on the TWIC program, visit the TSA TWIC website [tsa.gov] or the Coast Guard TWIC website [dco.uscg.mil].

**For active members only -** Once you renew your TWIC card, please send a copy of your TWIC card along with a copy of your paid receipt to the union hall and you will be reimbursed for the cost of renewing your TWIC card.

### **Notices from the Training Coordinator**

**Process Safety Management Reminder -** Please pay attention to the date of your last PSM class. This training needs to be updated yearly to gain access to the refineries.

Process Safety Management Class will be on March 17th and March 31st at 8:00 am.

**Common Arc Reminder** - Please remember to keep an eye on your common arc expiration date. Contact Matt Fink at the union hall if your common arc is ready to expire.

**M.O.S.T. Annual Drug Test Reminder** - Please pay attention to the date of your last MOST drug test. You must have a current M.O.S.T. drug test within a year to be eligible for work.

**MOST 5 Hour Reminder -** Please pay attention to the date of your last 5 Hour M.O.S.T. Refresher. This training needs to be updated once within 5 years to satisfy the referral rules.

Online Training - Effective January 1, 2017, all Boilermakers except new apprentices are required to utilize the MOST online training programs for the OSHA 5, 10 and 30-hour courses. Any member who requires training will need to submit a request through the hall, which will then be forwarded to MOST. MOST is not accepting individual, direct training requests. A valid email address will be required for all training requests.
