FROM THE DESK OF THE BUSINESS MANAGER

Nuclear Alert we will need manpower for a Nuclear Outage this fall at Peach Bottom. The outage will begin September 9, 2013. Pre-Screen dates will be as follows; if you have not worked in a nuclear plant for 1 year or more or initial access (P1) pre-screen dates will be 8/13, 8/15, 8/20, 8/22. If you have worked in a nuclear plant within the last year (P2) pre-screen dates will be 8/12, 8/14, 8/16, 8/19, 8/21, 8/23. Please call Tina at the union hall if you are interested in putting your name on the nuclear list for this job. Deadline for calling your name into the union hall for this job is August 2, 2013.

We are taking names for members who are interested in taking the Nuclear Equivalency Test. In order to be referred to work at a U.S. nuclear facility, you must be able to meet one of the following criteria: Boilermakers National Apprenticeship Program (BNAP) graduate, non-graduate apprentice must have 7,500 field hours before January 1, 1996, indentured apprentice, certified welder/special skill or successful completion of NMAP equivalency test. For those members who do NOT meet any of the criteria, an NMAP equivalency test will be administered at the union hall on Wednesday, July 31, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. To be eligible to take the test, you must meet ALL of the following requirements: must have current MOST drug test, 6,000 verified field hours, completed all MOST training programs: OSHA 10/30, Scaffold Erection, Steel Erection, and four (4) supplemental rigging modules. If you would like to register for the exam, please notify Tina at the union hall no later than Monday, July 22, 2013.
