\*\*\*Vacation Checks\*\*\* Will be distributed on December 1, 2017 between 9:00 a.m. and noon. No checks will be issued to any member whose monthly dues are in arrears or owe Local #13 any outstanding debt.

#### \*\*\*New DCR Requirements\*\*\*

As of October 16, 2017, all contractor employees will need current Process Safety Management (PSM) training to gain access to the Delaware City Refinery (DCR). Unfortunately, PSM training is not currently incorporated into the MOST-10 hour and is not accepted by DCR.

There are two ways to obtain PSM training: (1) Delaware Valley Safety Council (DVSC) or (2) Built-Rite. Initial DVSC training is \$80 per person; refresher training is \$65.00 per person. Classes are held every week. Built-Rite PSM training is administered by each of the building trades and classes are held periodically throughout the year. Upcoming Built-Rite classes will be posted on our website as we are notified.

We are in the process of certifying trainers through the hall. However, until we are fully capable of holding PSM classes through the hall, it will be necessary for each member to obtain PSM training either through DVSC or a Built-Rite PSM class held at another trade's training center. We appreciate your cooperation through this transition. Please contact he hall with any questions.



- Undergo clinical tests (blood draw, a physical examination, motor examination, memory tests)
- Have a picture of their brain taken using MRI
